### 5 MISCELLANEOUS

5.1 The Vice-Chancellor may determine fees to be paid by students: -

5.1.1 who are permitted to register for less than a session or who attend occasional classes or schedule or make use of the laboratories, library or other facilities of the University in **circumstances** for which no fee is prescribed in this Fees Ordinance.

5.1.2 who register for less than or more than a full degree programme.

5.1.3 for a course not included above until relevant fees have been prescribed by Ordinance.

**5.1.4** In determining such fees, the Vice-Chancellor shall have regard to the scale of fees set out herein.

## **6 FEES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

**6.1** Foundation Programme students shall be charged 60% of the tuition fees. Students from SADC member states shall pay tuition and ancillary fees as paid by local students.

**6.2** A person who is resident in Zimbabwe solely for the purpose of attending the University shall not be regarded as being resident in Zimbabwe for the purposes of Clause 6.1 above.

**6.3** Persons who are on the staff of a foreign embassy in Zimbabwe and the dependants of such persons shall be regarded as non-resident for the purpose of determining the fees to be paid by such persons for programmes undertaken at the University.

**7 ALL FEES IN THIS FEES ORDINANCE ARE PAYABLE IN THE USD WITH AN OPTION OF PAYING 50% IN THE LOCAL CURRENCY AT THE RULING INTERBANK RATE ON THE DAY OF PAYMENT.**

## **8 DATE OF OPERATION**

This schedule shall apply with effect from 1 January 2026, and shall remain in force until otherwise varied by a further Fees Ordinance of the Manicaland State University of Applied Sciences.
